STEP 1: SUBMIT APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

Fill in your application form. Then **FAX (8610) 8260-0030** or EMAIL scanned copies of the following to admission@prcstudy.com, followed by sending us the documents by mail.

1. Application form
2. A copy of High School, College or University diploma and transcript
3. Copy of passport (page with personal details and photo)
4. Copy of ID with contact information (i.e. Driver's license)
5. Resume (simple one page is sufficient)
6. Two reference letters from people other than family members
7. Copy of the payment receipt (i.e. telegraphic transfer for US\$300, of which includes the US\$100 Application Fee and US\$200 Program Deposit)
8. 6 Passport sized photos (4 weeks to 1 Semester students);
12 passport sized photos (1 academic year students)

Once PRC Study receives the documents above, we will process your application immediately. Within a few days, we will send an email or fax to confirm your program placement.

STEP 2: PAYMENT

Once your program placement is confirmed, you are required to pay the remainder of the Program Fees (Total Program Fees MINUS the US\$200 Program Deposit) before the program payment deadline. When total payment is received with payment receipt also faxed to PRC Study, we will send you a Pre-Arrival package along with the School Acceptance Letter, JW202 form or Invitation letter to you.

Payment Structure:

1. Application Fee US\$100 - Due in Step 1 when application is first submitted
2. Program Deposit US\$200 - Due also in Step 1 when application is first submitted
3. Remainder of Program Fee (Total Program Fee minus Program Deposit) - Due in Step 2 when Enrollment is being completed

When making the payment, please clearly identify your name and ensure that your name is indicated in the payment transaction. Please also note that the apply student is to pay all the bank charges on both ends. Please also email the TT transaction code to admission@prcstudy.com when payment has been made so that we can track your payment comes in.

Please note that the application fee is non-refundable. The program deposit will be deducted from your total program fees, and is also non-refundable, except under certain conditions, as outlined in the Program Terms & Conditions which is found on our website.

Payment Method:

STEP 4: VISA

Once you receive the School Acceptance Letter and the JW202 Form or Invitation Letter from PRC Study, you are to go to the nearest Chinese Embassy or Consulate in your home country to obtain your China Visa.

- **L Visa** - For students studying in China for 4 weeks (30 day stay)
- **F Visa** - For students studying in China for less than 6 months
- **X Visa** - For students studying in China for more than 6 months. Students applying for an X visa will also require a physical examination.

In most countries visa processing takes approximately 2 weeks, but some can take up to three months. Therefore, it is advised that you check with your nearest Chinese Embassy or Consulate about visa application processing time and to apply for your China visa as early as possible.

Documents Required By the Chinese Embassy or Consulate:

1. Visa Application Form (Obtained at the Chinese Embassy or Consulate Office & to be completed by you)
2. Copy of the School Acceptance Letter and JW202 Visa Form; OR Invitation Letter from PRC Study (Provided by PRC Study)
3. Valid passport (Your passport must be valid for a minimum of 6 months & for the duration of the program)
4. 2 Passport size photos (2x2 inch full-faced headshot, taken within the last 6 months)
5. Physical examination records (For X Visa applicants only)
6. Visa application fee

STEP 5: ARRIVING IN CHINA

Send a fax to (8610) 8260-0030 or email admission@prcstudy.com to advise PRC Study of your arrival information at least 10 days before your arrival in Beijing so that we can arrange your airport reception. Regarding your flight details, we would require the following information:

- 1) Flight Carrier's Name
- 2) Flight Number
- 3) City of Departure
- 4) Arrival date and time in Beijing
- 5) Estimated number of luggage you will bring so that we can coordinate the right sized car!

There are a couple of terminals in Beijing, so we want to make sure we pick you up at the right place. We will wait for you in the greeting hall (in the arrivals area where you come out just after you pick up your luggage) holding a PRC Study sign with your name(s) on it. Should your plane by chance depart late or arrive early, please try and notify us by calling (86) 1370 122 9226.

Please note PRC Study Program Fees do not include airfares.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. When do I apply?

We recommend students to apply as well in advance as possible for registration is based on a "first come, first served" basis. Early registration will also allow students enough time to make the necessary arrangements to come and study in China (i.e. visas).

2. Which university should I chose?

All of the universities are top-notch universities. Depending on what you are looking for, PRC Study is sure that one of the universities will be able to match your requirements. Please contact a PRC Study staff member to assist you selecting the right Chinese language study program.

3. How long should I study?

Students often show remarkable results only after 4 months of study (one semester in "A" level). Generally speaking, students who reach "D" Level (which generally takes three to four semesters to reach) will be able to read newspapers with ease. Speed of learning also depends on how dedicated you are to studying the Chinese language. The more you study, the faster you will learn. Being in China though will give you round the clock opportunity to practice with locals.

4. Can I still apply for a program if it is past the application deadline?

You must contact PRC Study to find out if the program is full. If it is not, you may still apply. However, if you are applying for a program after the application & enrollment deadline, you must pay the Application fee & FULL program fee when you send us your application form. It is recommended you check first with your nearest Chinese Visa Office about visa requirements to make sure you can obtain your visa in time.

5. Do I have to give a Chinese Name on the application form?

If you have a Chinese Name, you must include that in your application form. The Chinese university will require that for making your student ID card. If you do not have a Chinese Name, then the accepting university will create one for you.

6. How do I know what level to apply for?

A placement test is given to all students on the first day of the program.

7. When are program fees due?

Program fees are due in full by the enrollment and payment deadline. Full program fees must be paid to PRC Study first before the University Admission letter and the JW202 forms will be sent to you.

8. Do I need to provide any of my own study materials?

No. PRC Study provides textbooks and a dictionary for our students.

9. Can I get credited at my existing university?

Yes. All of our partner universities are reputable and well-established and have been taking credit earning students from other universities around the world for many years. However, the applying student must check with their home university to determine whether they will accept the credits and exactly what requirements they will require.

10. How do I get a Visa?

When PRC Study receives you're your full program payment, we will send you a Student Information Package. This package will contain the necessary documents for you to go and apply for a Visa at the Chinese Visa Office in your home country. A medical examination may also be required depending on which country you are coming from and your intended length of stay in China.

Frequently Asked Questions Continued

11. Will I need medical insurance?

Required by the Chinese Government, all international students must have medical insurance when studying in China. For your convenience and safety, medical insurance is included in PRC Study's total program fees.

12. What vaccinations do I need for China?

The following vaccinations and applicable frequencies are recommended for students coming to China: Hepatitis A (within previous 10 years); Hepatitis B (within previous 5 to 10 years), Japanese B Encephalitis (within previous 3 years); Tetanus (within previous 10 years); Polio (within previous 10 years); and Typhoid (once in lifetime). Students 55 and older should also have a Pneumococcal Vaccine.

13. How much do meals cost?

Campus cafeterias offer a single dish meal with rice for as little as 4 RMB per person. On and off campus Local Chinese restaurants offer meals for about 10 - 20 RMB per person. Finer western restaurants offer meals from about 50 to 100 RMB per person.

14. Money

If you intend to stay in Beijing for several months, you should plan to have money for your everyday expenses, including food, entertainment, transportation, and so on. You can try and use ATM machines to withdraw money from your home bank account or a better method is to carry Traveler's checks, which tends to be the safest and most reliable. Participants enrolled in longer courses may wish to open a Chinese bank account and transfer funds from their home country.

15. I want a job but I don't want to teach English, can I find work in other sectors?

Yes. Through our work placement program you can find an internship with a Chinese company.

16. Is Internet Access Available?

Internet access is provided free to PRC Study participants through computer stations in the PRC Study Student Lounge. In-home Internet access for interested students can also be arranged. However, the individual must pay for connection and usage fees, which are relatively cheap in China. In addition, Internet access is also available in the many Internet Cafes found throughout the university areas. Sometimes some individuals experience difficulties receiving emails when connecting with their home ISP servers, therefore it is suggested that individuals also set up an email account with Yahoo or Hotmail.

17. What voltage is used in China?

The electricity voltage in Beijing is 220. To be able to use your electrical appliances brought from your home country, you may need to use a transformer or adapter, which can be purchased locally in China.

18. What do I need to bring with me to China?

You can find almost every product and brand in Beijing as you would in your home country, including soap, shampoo, toothpaste, drinks and so on.

- Medication: We suggest you bring sufficient prescription medication or preferred over-the-counter medication (i.e. Tylenol, cold & flu tablets, etc.) from your home country to last for the duration of your visit, as these may not be readily available in China.
- Clothing and Shoes: You will find clothing and shoes readily available and at very inexpensive prices. However, larger sizes may be harder to find.
- Household Items: Smaller items, including electronics, furniture, cleaning supplies, linens and blankets can all be bought quite cheaply in stores.
